## HOW TO FIND US

### USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT TRAVELING IN PRAGUE

#### SUMMARY

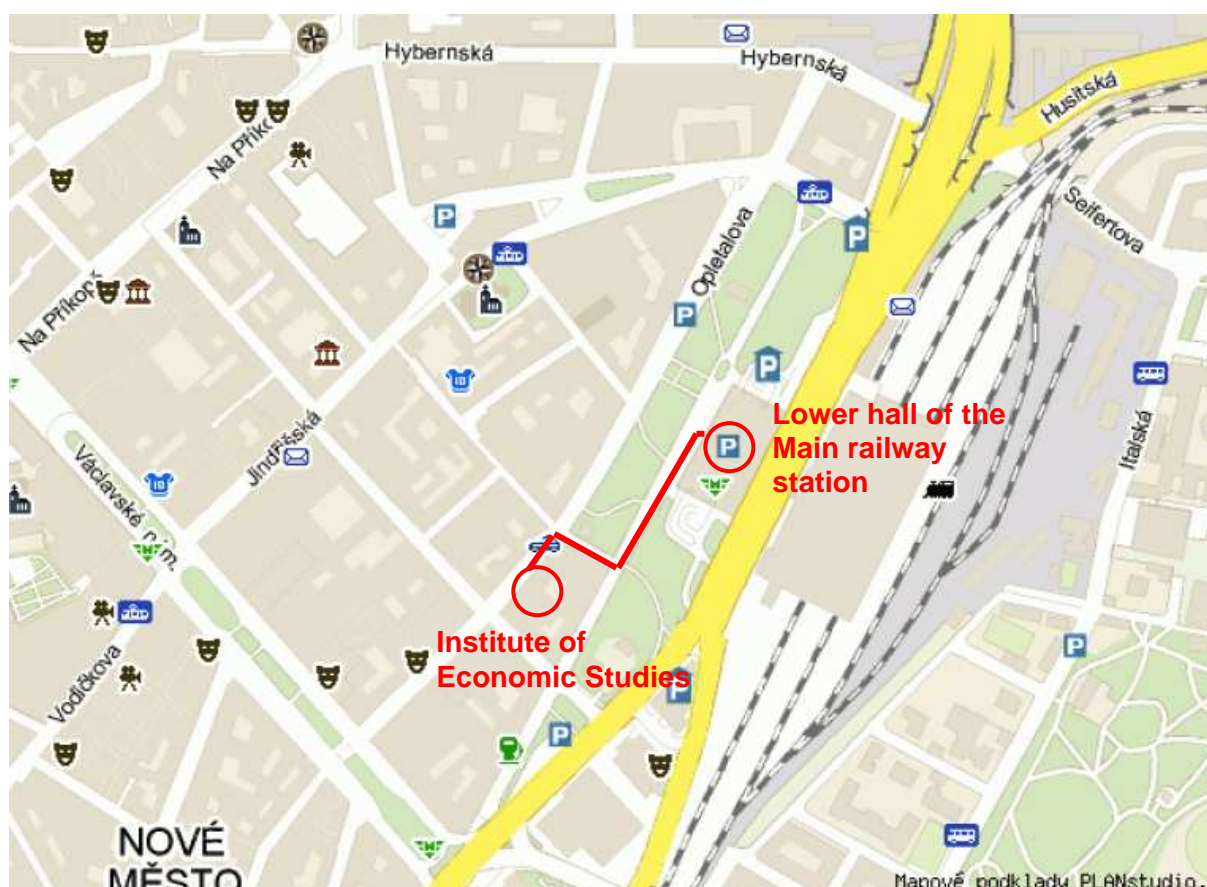
1. How to get from airport to conference venue

#### 1. How to get from airport to conference venue

##### Option A

From the airport you can take [Airport Express \(AE\)](#) bus line from Airport Terminal North 2 to Railway Station “Hlavní nádraží”. Bus line operates at regular interval of 30 minutes (from 5.48 a.m. to 9.18 p.m.). Bus stop Terminál 2 is in front of the Arrival hall. It costs 50 CZK for a one-hour use of this line only. It takes about 49 minutes, no change. From Railway Station “Hlavní nádraží”, it takes only 3-5 minutes to walk to the Institute (Opletalova street, number 26); see map below.

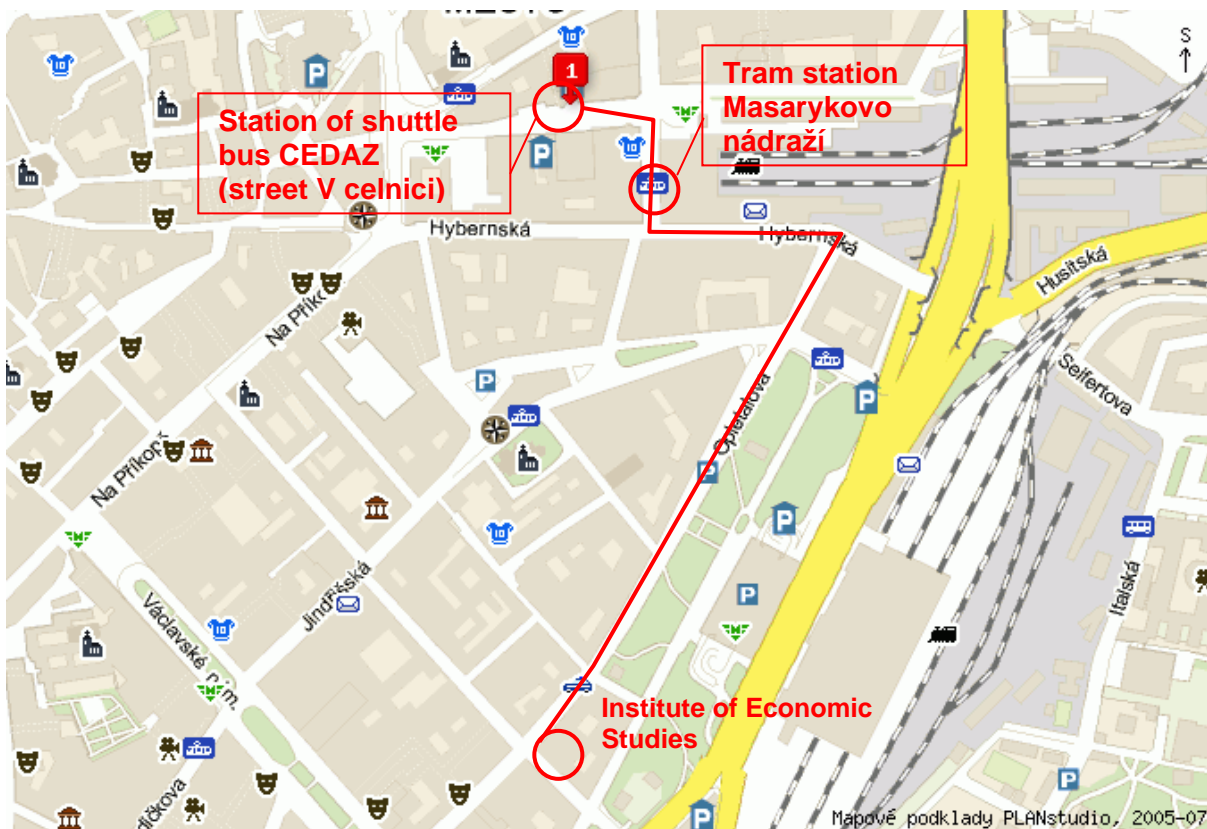

## Option B

From the airport you can also use shuttle bus CEDAZ between Prague airport and the city centre (street V celnici). It departs from the airport (in front of the Arrival hall) daily every 30 minutes from 6 am to 9 pm. The ticket to the city centre costs 120,- CZK. Further information about this transportation can be found on [www.cedaz.cz](http://www.cedaz.cz). From the station of CEDAZ shuttle bus in the centre it takes about 10 minutes to walk to the Institute. Please, see the map 2.

## Option C

From the airport take bus 119 (direction Dejvicka, it operates frequently, with usual interval from 8 to 10 minutes) and go to Dejvicka metro station. It takes about 25 minutes. Here, you can change for the underground. Go by the underground (denoted by line "A" in green color) to station Muzeum (the fifth station). This station is located on the upper part of the Wenceslaw's square. From here, it takes only 3-5 minutes to walk to the Institute (Opletalova street, number 26); see map 3 below.

## 2. How to get from the Main Railway Station to conference venue

It takes about 3 minutes to walk from the Main Railway Station to the Institute. Get out of the lower hall (see location of hall on the map below), turn left and cross the park (informally called Sherwood) and you will be in the Opletalova street. Continue to the left and after a minute you'll be in front of the Institute.

#### Option A

From airport take the AE (Airport Express) bus line to Railway station “Masarykovo nádraží”, it takes about 39 minutes. Here change for the tram number 5 or 14 or 26. Go 2 stops only to the tram station “Dlouhá třída” (it takes 3 min.). From tram station “Dlouhá třída” walk 3 min to hotel: from “Revoluční” street turn to “Dlouhá” street, than second cross right to “Rybná” and than right again to our street “Haštalská”. After 50m on the right side you will find the hotel. See map below.

#### Option B

From airport take the AE bus or bus 119 (direction Dejvicka) and go by tram number 26 to station “Dlouhá třída” (8<sup>th</sup> stop). It takes about 17 minutes. From tram station “Dlouhá třída” walk 3 min to hotel: from “Revoluční” street turn to “Dlouhá” street, than second cross right to “Rybná” and than right again to our street “Haštalská”. After 50m on the right side you will find the hotel. See map 5 above.

#### Option C

From the airport you can also use regular shuttle bus CEDAZ between Prague airport and the city centre (street V celnici). It departs from the airport (in front of the arrival hall) daily every 30 minutes from 6 am to

9 pm. The ticket to the city centre costs 120,- CZK. Further information about this transportation can be found on [www.cedaz.cz](http://www.cedaz.cz). From the station of CEDAZ shuttle bus in the centre walk 2 minutes to the tram station Masarykovo nábřeží (see the map 2). Here change for the tram number 5 or 14 or 26. Go 2 stops only to the tram station “Dlouhá třída” (it takes 3 min.). From tram station “Dlouhá třída” walk 3 min to hotel: from “Revoluční” street turn to “Dlouhá” street, than second cross right to “Rybná” and than right again to our street “Haštalská”. After 50m on the right side you will find the hotel. See map 5.

#### 4. How to get from Hotel Rubicon to the Institute

From tram station “Dlouhá třída” take tram 5 or 26 to the station Hlavní nádraží (tram 9 – eighth station, tram 5 – tenth station). Then, walk along the park another 7 minutes to the Institute – please, see Map 6.

#### Tickets for Prague public transport:

There are two types of tickets – transfer and non-transfer. A *transfer ticket* costs 26 CZK and can be used 75 minutes from validation. A *non-transfer ticket* costs 18 CZK and applies to trams and buses 20 minutes allowing no change. On the underground non-transfer tickets are valid for the distance of 5 stations from the station of validation (not including the station of validation) allowing to change between the lines A,B,C, but no longer than 30 minutes.
